



Medical Technical Lyceum **Action plan 2015-2020**

1. To write a letter to the Ministry for Education and science with the suggestion to include the school in the list of the Oblast supported projects. Gain support from Moscow school of Economics as a partner school of the lyceum.
2. To actively participate in the IBSA (International Baccalaureate School Association) of Russia in the governing body to promote the acceptance of the IB at the state level as mutually recognized diploma.
3. Add new pages to the Diploma programme part of the web site and revise the old pages. Add alumni page to the site, with the advice to current students. To show how TOK, CAS helped them in their lives.
4. Attract attention of our students to use IB resources www.ibo.org for them to be able to communicate with the children from IB world schools and to open a special CAS project with the use of the site.
5. Order software simulation of real experiments to give students the wider access to the ICT technologies. Also our plans are to substitute books by e-books.
6. Revise a continuous development programme for teachers, which will allow them to be involved in studying English more.
7. Continue offering the summer language courses for children who have difficulties with the language in the 8-9 forms which will prepare them better for the IB DP.
8. Revise working programmes that are based on new language policy from the primary level and up to the 11th form using new course books and additional materials.
9. Revise on to the new teaching plans in English (based on the language policy).
10. Keep using the first day of the holidays for IB teachers' meetings.
11. To give the school physiologist a task to revise a workshop (a seminar) on decision-making both for parents and students.
12. To publish revised curriculum to all members of the school community.
13. Revise the manual on working with the parents on further choice of their educational path.
14. Have an agreement with an educational agency on providing educational consultancy help for the lyceum students.

15. To collect a bank of support educational materials to be used for subject-teachers for practicing language and terminology.
16. To promote www.occ.org a strong and powerful tool of discussion between subject teachers.
17. Support IB teachers in their strive towards becoming IB examiners in order to have at least 3 more IB examiners by 2020.
18. Support IB teachers in their strive to take part in Curriculum review committee.
19. To organize seminars for teachers on TOK, CAS and Externed Essay.
20. To organize joint seminars for teachers and students on TOK, CAS and Extented Essay.
21. For the group of teachers to continue working on the assessment policy and finalize it. Include the reflection of students into it.
22. Plan a number of seminars on the issues of assessment and marking for the IB teachers.
23. To publish up-to-date Extended essay guide and Handbook for a candidate guide.
24. To prepare a CAS brochure in Russian for class advisors.
